The Grand Lodge of Ohio awards two scholastic scholarship per district (except in larger districts three are awarded)

One of the recipients of the Grand Lodge Scholarship is a graduate of Adena High School in Frankfort. She Ms. Ella Anderson, daughter of Mr. Kent Anderson and his Harnessing Technology—Tammy Laughlin, media specialist at Circleville Elementary works with second through fifth graders to get them started on research projects. Tammy uses INFOhio, a digital library for prekindergarten through 12th grade, to teach children the Super3 and the Bigo6, learning methods that teach them how to find information and then use, apply and evaluate what they've found. The Super 3 is based on the Bigo6 but given to second-graders in s smaller dose. The students will complete the second phase by getting information from INFOhio database, which is a good introduc-

tion for them to use the Dewey Decimal System to find books. This is the first year for this program


