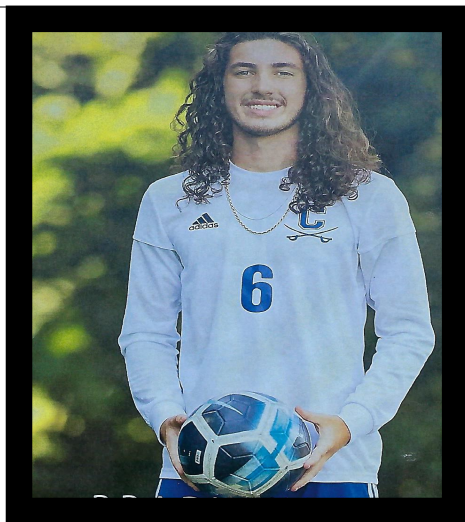
2022 SCIOTO LODGE SCHOLARSHIP RECIPIENTS
