Sir Knight Ash Awarded Highest Honor

At this years Grand Commandery Conclave, Sir Knight Michael A. Ash was awarded the oldest and highest honor a Grand Commandery can bestow. The Knights Templar Cross of Honor or KTCH which is actually presented through the Grand Encampment of the United States of America.

This award was first approved in 1964, ironically the year in which Sir Knight Ash was born, and is still being presented today.

A nomination for the award shall be made by the Grand Commandery of which the nominee is a member and must be submitted in writing and approved by the Grand Commander of the respective state. The award shall be made only for exceptional and meritorious service rendered to the order, far beyond the call of duty, and beyond the service usually expected of an officer or member. No present or past elected grand officer of a Grand Commandery shall be eligible for the award. One nomination may be made from each Grand Commandery, regardless of the number of members, plus one additional nomination may be made from a Grand Commandery for each 5,000 members or major fraction thereof, during any one year.

The award shall consist of a gold medal upon the center of which shall be a Patriarchal Cross in purple. Around the cross shall be inscribed the words "Knights Templar Cross of Honor." A lapel pin in the form of the medal as described above shall also be provided. A suitable certificate of award shall be issued by the Grand Encampment and signed by the Grand Master and the Grand Recorder bearing the seal of the Grand Encampment.

Masonic Temple Association

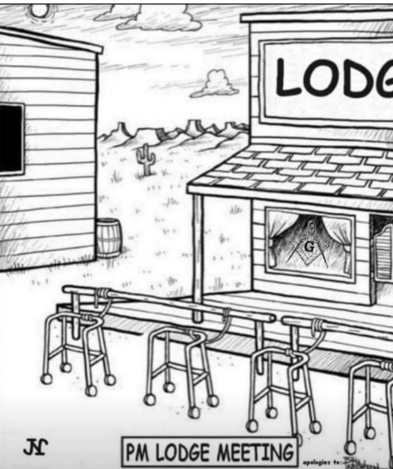
